PRESIDENT LUNGU HAPPY WITH NATIONAL HOUSE OF PRAYER PROGRESS

LUSAKA, (Thursday, 26th December, 2019)---His Excellency, **Dr Edgar Chagwa Lungu, President of the Republic of Zambia** today made an impromptu visit to the site of the National House of Prayer and is impressed with work so far done.

The site for the interdenominational church is on Burma Road in Woodlands.

The President was briefed on progress by Task Force Commander Col. Mvula from the Zambia Army who said that construction of the House will commence in January.

The Church will be built by a combined team of the Zambia Army and the Zambia National Service.

The President told Col. Mvula to expedite the works.

"Zambia is blessed because we are Christian Nation, and the National House of Prayer will further galvanise us as Christians. I am determined to see this project through," the President said.

The President was accompanied by State House members of staff, including Presidential Affairs Minister Hon. Freedom Sikazwe and Secretary to the Cabinet Dr Simon Miti.
