## **PRESIDENT LUNGU MOURNS SENIOR CHIEF NDUNGU**

**LUSAKA, (Thursday, 30th January, 2020)---**His Excellency, **Dr Edgar Chagwa Lungu, President of the Republic of Zambia**, is saddened by the death of Senior Chief Ndungu of the Luvale people of North western Province.

President Lungu says the death of the traditional leader is a great loss not just to the Luvale people but the entire nation.

The President said it is unfortunate that Senior Chief Ndungu has died a few days after the country lost Chief Nyamphande of the Nsenga People.
