

PRESIDENT LUNGU DISTURBED BY SECOND TRAGIC MISHAP

Lusaka, (6th March, 2020)----- **His Excellency Dr. Edgar Chagwa Lungu, President of the Republic of Zambia** is disturbed that a separate second tragic accident has happened on Kitwe-Kalulushi Road, Copperbelt Province on Friday claiming 14 lives, few hours after the first mishap occurred on Ndola-Kapiri Road leaving 12 people dead.

The President says it is unfortunate that 26 people have died in one day, people who could have contributed to national development.

"It is with deep regret that I have learnt of the second accident which has claimed 14 people bringing the number of those who have died in two separate accidents in one day to 26. I sympathise with the families who have lost their loved ones in this latest disaster," the President said.

And the President has urged the Road Traffic and Safety Agency (RTSA) and the Zambia Police Service to ensure that they work closely to bring sanity on the roads across the country.
